Submission Of Annual Compliance Assessment Report

Following referral to the Environmental Protection Authority in August 2010, the Fitzgerald River National Park coastal walk trail was approved by the Minister for Environment subject to a number of conditions, as detailed in Ministerial Statement 884. This includes submitting an annual Compliance Assessment Report (CAR) detailing the Department of Parks and Wildlife's compliance to the conditions in Statement 884.

The attached CAR for 2013 details the projects compliance to the pre-construction conditions and start of construction for the second year of implementation of this project. The project has been compliant with all the conditions and processes required under Statement 884.

This CAR, along with supporting documents, is attached for submission to the Office of the Environmental Protection Authority (OEPA) in compliance with Condition 4-6 of Statement 884. Prior to submission, this document requires endorsement by the Director General on page 25 of the document.

The OEPA requires one hard copy and one electronic copy (preferably PDF on CD or thumb drive) of this CAR and supporting documents to be submitted to the General Manager, OEPA, marked to the attention of Manager, Compliance Branch by 22 March 2014. Due to delay in compiling the report a draft copy of the report has been sent to the EPA on their advice for noting to ensure that the Ministerial Statement condition deadline is met.

Following submission, the OEPA requires that the approved CAR is made publicly available within 14 days of submission to the OEPA. The web address at which the documents can be accessed is then required to be provided to the OEPA's Compliance Branch within 14 days of the documents becoming publicly available. Stakeholders involved in the project also need to be informed by email that the documents are available online. A copy of this CAR must also be kept in the Parks and Wildlife library.
