

## Fees for Phytophthora Dieback Interpreters for Registration, Evaluation, Mentoring and Training

Fees current as from 1/09/2025

The following services and fees apply when not employed by DBCA:

- **Core Competency Evaluation**
  - Upon nomination by mentor Interpreter, evaluation to obtain Interpreter registration
  - Desktop mapping exercise and evaluation at field simulation site
- **Supplementary Competency Evaluation**
  - For those Interpreters seeking additional qualifications beyond core competency
  - Upon nomination by mentor Interpreter, evaluation at field simulation site
- **Mentoring and Training**
  - Available on a day fee-for-service basis through the Plant Diseases Program
  - Customised training options for either individuals or organisations
- **Annual Registration Maintenance**
  - Interpreters not employed by DBCA are invoiced annually to maintain registration
  - Renewal requires payment and submission of a signed declaration

### Important Notes

- Fees for evaluations are **non-refundable**, even if the applicant does not pass
- Successful applicants receive a Letter of Registration valid for the current period
- Re-evaluation is permitted once the mentor Interpreter deems the applicant ready
