

# Djarlgarro Beeliar pools

## Canning River pools

### Baseline surveys completed

One year of biodiversity, hydrology, sediment and water quality surveys completed across 10 river pools in the Djarlgarro (Canning), Southern and Wungong rivers

### Native populations

Found over 13,000 native djiljit (fish) and 4,000 marron and gilgies

### Macroinvertebrates

Identified abundant mussel and macroinvertebrate populations

### Non-natives

Removed 12,000 feral and introduced fish and crayfish from the system

### Animal tracking

Documented connectivity between pools for freshwater cobbler, snake-neck yarkan (turtles), western minnows and nightfish

### Engagement

Sought Whadjuk cultural advice and enlisted 17 volunteers and 37 student interns across UWA, MU and ECU

### Next Steps

We are currently in the process of identifying pool/s for future intervention works to improve in-stream habitat
